

Guidelines for 3DInCites Knowledge Portal Article Contributors

The 3D InCites Knowledge Portal is an open-source resource library of contributed technology features, white papers, book reviews, and market research on 3D integration topics. Our goal is to provide our readers with free access to the latest technical information available that will help further the development and commercialization of 3D integration technologies. We are actively recruiting contributions of 3D-related original content for publication. We will also accept open-source white papers and presentations that have permission to be re-posted on 3D InCites; or linked to from the 3D InCites knowledge portal.

Steps for Publication:

- Submit a 100-200 word abstract on a topic related to 3D packaging, 3D IC, monolithic 3D approaches, 3D system integration, or interposer technology. Once approved, a deadline date will be agreed upon. Since 3D InCites is an online platform and frequently updated, deadlines are somewhat flexible. We do ask that you stick to the agreed-upon deadline so that we can schedule workflow accordingly.
- Technology features should be 800-1500 words, 3-5 figures in .jpg or .png format. Image flies must be under 2MB. All posts are subject to the approval of 3D InCites editors.
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- To ensure the highest quality in our publication, abstracts may be reviewed not only by 3D InCites editorial director, but submitted to our technical advisory board for further review before acceptance.
